2018 FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Competitor,

Thank you for your entry for this year's event. Your start number is shown on the attached entry list. If you have been seeded in the wrong event, i.e. are in the Rally but had intended to enter the Run, or vice versa, please contact the Organisers soon as possible, do not leave it until signing-on.

As many of you will know, late last year, we lost a long-time stalwart of the organising team Alastair Tullie, who had been ill for the last few years with MS, his help and support will be greatly missed by all the team.

The club, led by our President Nick Pullan, is supporting the Multiple Sclerosis Society by raising funds for the charity. In your rally pack you will find a couple of stickers promoting this and £5.00 per entry is being donated to the charity - feel free to donate more at Saturday signing on or the finish if you wish. Also, club member Doreen Simpson has kindly donated some hand turned wooden crafts made by her late husband Tony. AMENDMENTS TO SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 7 Certain sections of public road will be used more than once during the day to and from the test venues, lunch halt and the start / finish venue. Some part of these roads may also be used on regularity sections. Unless specified in the navigational instructions no road will be used more than once as regularity.
- 11 Club Stewards: delete Steve Stringwell; add Ian Doble.
- 14 A master schedule included with these instructions gives the general timing of the event. Times shown are for car zero. The specific locations will be included in the schedule in your roadbook. Run competitors can collect their tulip roadbook from the signing-on desk on Sunday morning. **Please present Time Card One at signing-on and you will be issued with your roadbook.**
- 15 Arrival after due time at a Main Time Control or Time Control 30 marks per minute

PRE-START PROCEDURE

SATURDAY

Noise and Scrutineering venues open at 17:00 and close at 19:00. After completing both, proceed to signing-on, which closes at 19:30.

NOISE & SCRUTINEERING are at St Mary's Academy, Bradford Road, Menston LS29 6AE. Please see attached map. There is one entrance to the venue at 104 / 179½ 431½. Firstly you will need to turn left for the Noise Test - noise level must not exceed 98dB(A) @ 2/3rd of maximum rpm at 0.5 metres. Then exit the venue at 104 / 179 432¾, turning left to re-enter the venue, this time turning right to Scrutineering. Then exit the venue at 104 / 179½ 429¾.

Ensure you bring your V5 vehicle log book and current MOT certificate if applicable.

Please note:

MSA Regulation R19.7.5: tyre aspect ratio less than 65% is prohibited.

As the event includes Special Tests on private property, you must carry a small spill kit.

Electronic devices that carry out more functions than simple distance or time measurement are prohibited from all competing cars.

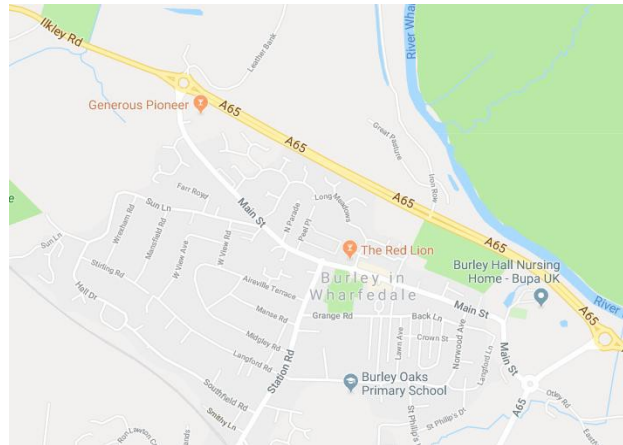


We suggest you use the A65 between Scrutineering and Signing on to by-pass Burley-in-Wharfedale.

SIGNING-ON will be at The Generous Pioneer, Ilkley Road, Burley in Wharfedale, LS29 7HR, just off the A65, see map below (MR 104 / 161 469). Both Driver and Navigator should attend, bringing with you the process sheet from noise & scrutineering, Competition Licences (Rally competitors only), Club Membership Cards, Insurance documents and any outstanding payments. You will receive your rally pack, which will contain 2 rally plates, 2 sets of numbers, 2 Supporting MS Stickers, 2 each lunch and finish tickets, special test details, a Road Book (Rally competitors only), a results query sheet and Time Cards 1 to 4 on a clip board fitted with a timing chip.

R 6.1.1 - The requirements of this clause are revised as follows: Rally Plates shall be affixed to the front (as nearly vertical as possible) and rear of the car. Numbers should be affixed to the rear windows on both sides of the car. The Scrutineer will be checking rally plates are correctly fitted at the start line.

SUNDAY

SCRUTINEERING & NOISE will be located at the area marked on the Start venue map from 07:00 to 08:00. Ensure you bring your V5 vehicle log book and current MOT certificate if applicable.

Please note:

MSA Regulation R19.7.5 - tyre aspect ratio less than 65% is prohibited.

As the event includes Special Tests on private property, you must carry a small spill kit.

Electronic devices that carry out more functions than simple distance or time measurement are prohibited from all competing cars.

SIGNING-ON will be inside the Millstones, from 07:00 to 08:30. Both Driver and Navigator should attend, bringing with you the process sheet from noise & scrutineering, Competition Licences (Rally competitors only), Club Membership Cards, Insurance documents and any outstanding payments. You will receive your rally pack, which will contain 2 rally plates, 2 sets of numbers, 2 each lunch and finish tickets, special test details, a Road Book, a results query sheet and Time Cards 1 to 4 on a clip board fitted with a timing chip.

PARKING is limited at the start, see additional instructions below.

Additional Instructions

BEFORE THE EVENT:

PETROL – For those requiring fuel on Saturday evening there is a BP petrol station next to the Wetherby Whaler, less than half a mile from scrutineering, there are also several garages in the Otley area. On Sunday morning the nearest fuel to the start venue is at Shell, Ripon Rd, Harrogate (24 hrs) at 104 / 296 566. (Fuel is available along the route after approximately 70 miles).

TRAILERS – There is no parking space for trailers at the Generous Pioneer on Saturday evening. There is some parking on the A65, just past the roundabout (west side) at the junction with The Generous Pioneer. This is space at the side of the main road.

There will be limited space to unload cars from trailers at scrutineering, trailers must not be left overnight, we cannot guarantee that you will be able to access them the following day.

Limited parking for trailers is available at the start venue, you must park in a line on the right of the hardcore area as directed by the marshals. The lay-by near the venue on the opposite side of the A59 will be used for overflow trailer and vehicle parking. If using this area please do not obstruct the western end where Regularity 3 Start is located. See start venue diagram attached. Vehicles and trailers are parked at venues at competitors' own risk.

REFRESHMENTS – The Generous Pioneer will be serving food, they have suggested that if you wish to eat, there that you pre-book your table, and if possible pre-order food to save delays.

The Millstones will be serving bacon and sausage butties from 07:15 hrs on Sunday.

MEASURED DISTANCES - See attached map of the Saturday and Sunday measured distances.

Note that electronic distance recorders displaying average speed may not be used. These will be checked at scrutineering and again during the event.

ON THE EVENT:

ROAD CONDITIONS - Some of the roads used have deep potholes thanks to the harsh Yorkshire weather. Please drive carefully!

TIMING POINTS – There are no intermediate regularity controls situated on A class roads. When travelling on an A class road please keep up with the flow. There will be no intermediate control for a least 0.25 miles after you have turned off an A road and you will not be penalised for 'stopping and waiting' within this distance to lose any time gained.

DRIVING STANDARDS – A list of Driving Standards Observers will be displayed on the official notice board at the start. We have occasionally had reports in the past of poor driving standards from competitors. Please remember that normal traffic laws apply on the event and you must be courteous to other road users (including walkers, cyclists and riders). Reports regarding championship contenders will be passed onto co-ordinators for future rounds.

POLICE - We have been advised that the local Road Policing department may undertake checks along the route so as to enforce speed limits etc.

PRIVATE PROPERTY - All private property used on the event has Landowner's permission.

SPECIAL TESTS - For safety reasons, competitors will not be allowed to walk forward beyond the Test Start Control to look at tests, or leave the immediate vicinity of their cars at test starts. Please note that the tests are on property normally closed to public access. In order that we may retain these in future, there will be no public access to test sites either before or during the event. Any recce-ing of any of the private venues is forbidden - PENALTY: DISQUALIFICATION. All tests are held on private property.

ROUTE – The routes for both events are similar but not identical. It would be foolish for Rally competitors to wait and then follow the Run competitors – you will more than likely be led onto the wrong route! Any competitors caught divulging route information to other competitors or spectators will be disqualified.

ROUTE DEFINITION FOR RUN COMPETITORS - You will receive a detailed tulip road book, including maps, for the whole route, there is no need to plot the route on to OS maps. You may wish to carry a road atlas (or copies of OS Landranger maps 99 & 104 if you have them), for use in the unlikely event that any enforced route amendments on the day are not covered by the road book maps.

ARROWS - Certain junctions or sections will be arrowed, these will be Orange dayglow with ILKLEY & DMC printed on the arrow. We recommend you follow these arrows!

LUNCH HALT – Food may be purchased at the lunch halt, should any non-competitors wish. First car due at approx. 11:20 hrs.

MTC 4 / FINISH – N.B. there are no lateness penalties other than OTL. First car due at 16:16. The carvery supper will be followed by the Prize Presentation as soon as results are available. Additional carvery tickets may be purchased at Signing-on at a cost of £16.50 each.

POST EVENT Q & A SESSION As on previous HRCR rounds there will be a Q and A session after the rally for the novices to understand where and how they may have made mistakes during the day. Further details will be on the Official Noticeboard.

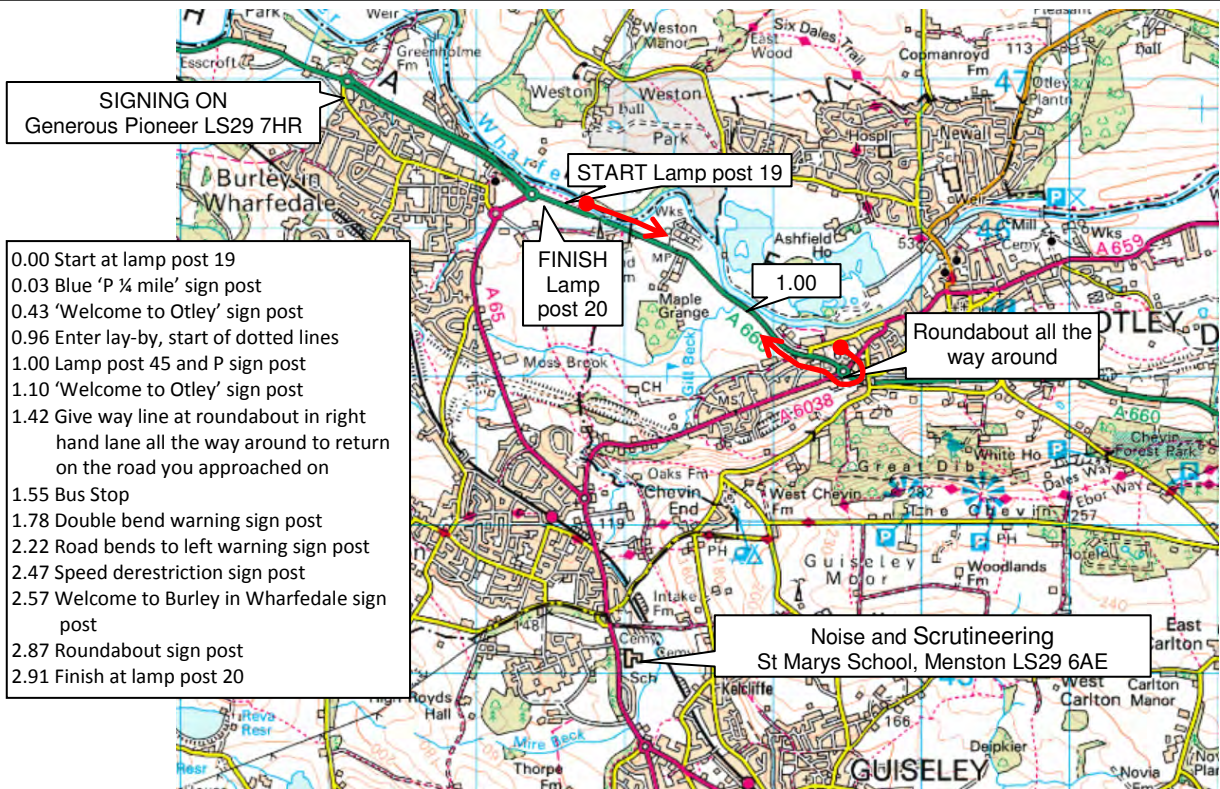

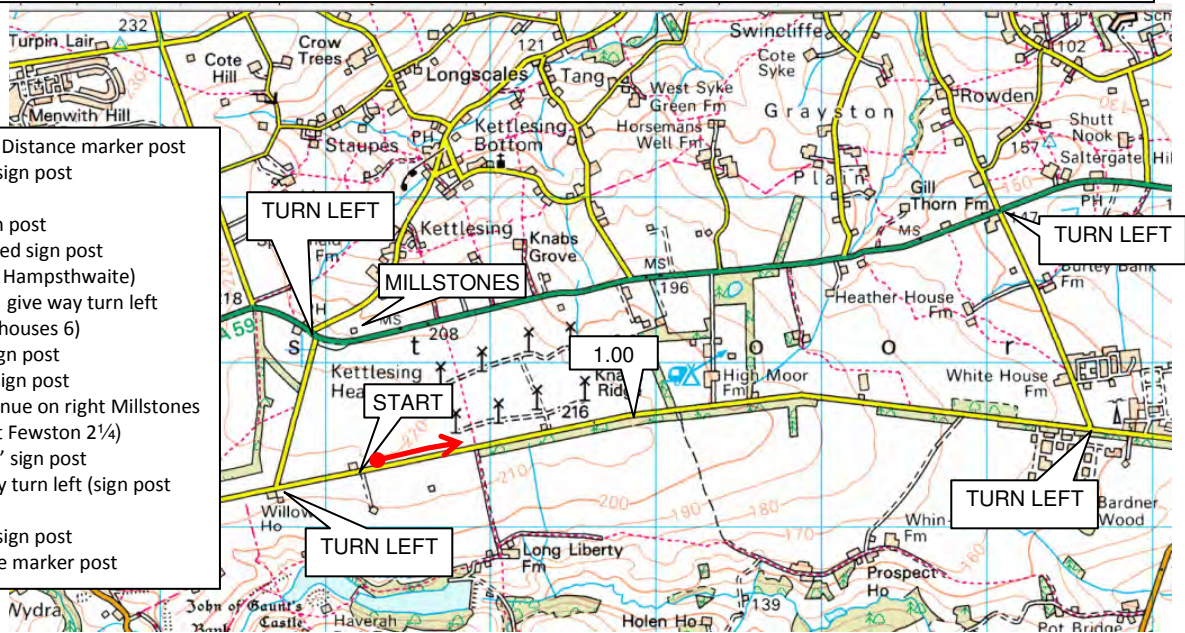

SATURDAY Measured distance near Scrutineering and Signing On. A return route on the A660, 150yds from the A660/A65 roundabout, at 104 / 175462 approach from WNW and depart ESE. At the roundabout all the way around to return on the road you approached on.



- 0.00 Start at lamp post 19
- 0.03 Blue 'P ¼ mile' sign post
- 0.43 'Welcome to Otley' sign post
- 0.96 Enter lay-by, start of dotted lines
- 1.00 Lamp post 45 and P sign post
- 1.10 'Welcome to Otley' sign post
- 1.42 Give way line at roundabout in right hand lane all the way around to return on the road you approached on
- 1.55 Bus Stop
- 1.78 Double bend warning sign post
- 2.22 Road bends to left warning sign post
- 2.47 Speed derestriction sign post
- 2.57 Welcome to Burley in Wharfedale sign post
- 2.87 Roundabout sign post
- 2.91 Finish at lamp post 20

SUNDAY Measured distance near Start venue. A return route starts on Penny Pot Lane at 104 / 222½ 553½ approach from the WSW and depart ENE. After the 1.00 distance marker take the first left turn sign post Hampsthwaite. At the crossroads give way and turn left onto the A59. Stay on the A59 to the start venue the Millstones or to return to the measured distance start continue on the A59 past Millstones and take the first signed junction left. At the T junction give way and turn left back onto Penny Pot Lane to return to the start

- 2.53 '50' maximum speed sign post

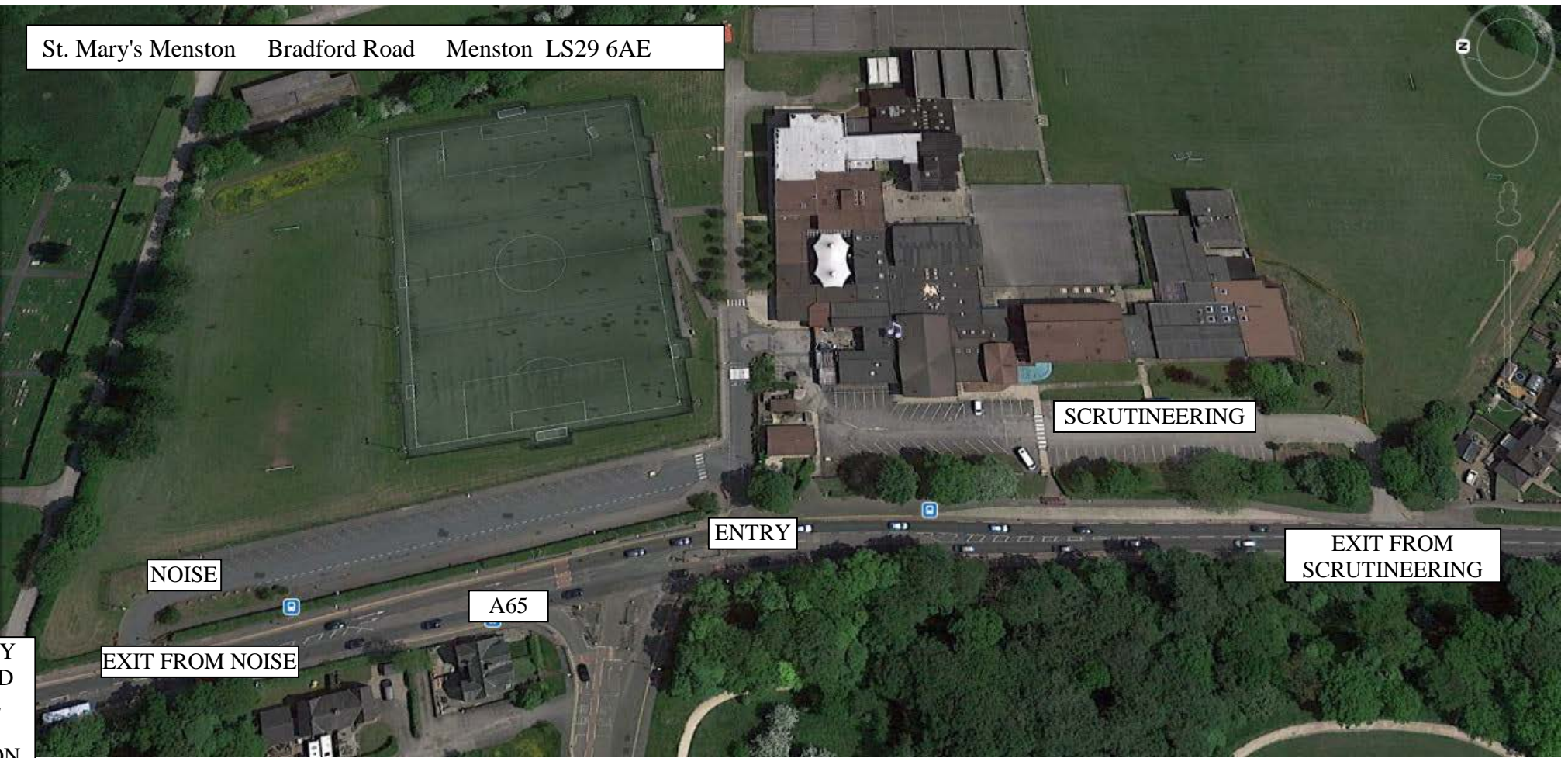
